This form is valid indefinitely from the date you sign it.

It is *your responsibility* to let us know if you want to change or withdraw your agreement at any time.

- Historic photographs will remain on our website and social media feeds unless requested in writing to be removed.
- We will not use the personal details or full names (which means first name and surname) of you in a photographic image on video, on our website.
- We will not include personal e-mail, postal addresses or telephone number on our website, or in other social media channels.
- If we use a full name in the text on our website or social media channels, we will not use a photograph of that person to accompany the article.
- We may use group photographs or footage with very general labels, such as “a recent wedding” or “latest cheerleading routine”.
- We will only use images of people who are suitably dressed, to reduce the risk of such images being used inappropriately.
- I understand that images on websites can be viewed throughout the world and not just in the United Kingdom and that some overseas countries may not provide the same level of protection to the rights of individuals as EU/UK legislation provides.
- Images are securely stored electronically and indefinitely. If in the future you wish to have your image(s) deleted, it is your responsibility to contact us.
- Collected data (name, address etc.) are securely stored. This data is never passed on or sold.
- Images taken at events sometimes are placed online for sale.
- All image(s) will remain the property of Damian Pudner Photography unless written confirmation is given releasing the rights.

Your rights

- You have the right to request, to see a copy of the information (images) we hold about you and to request deletions of the information (images). You can ask us to stop using your images at any time, in which case it will not be used in future publications/posts but may continue to appear in publications (and social media) which are already in circulation.
